5. Residents have reported that there is a need for double yellow lines on the hill from the phone box up to the bend on Forge Road (opposite the canal car park). At times on weekends we feel trapped and can't turn right coming out of our drive.
Also there needs to be a 20 MPH speed limit from the river bridge up to the junction at Cwm Crawnnon road as the speed of some traffic is ridiculously fast.

6. Parking outside the pre-school entrance has been reported as problematic by a resident. Pictures show that the parking problems can happen at any

time of day and are to be circulated at the meeting. To be discussed and action agreed.

7. A temporary contractor cleaner is needed for the public toilets and the car park in Cwm Crawnon Road. Applications are to be considered and one selected to start on 6th September, to be renewed on a monthly basis.
8. A request has come in for used of access to the river for the NHS. The section in question runs upstream for approximately 400 meters of Llangynidr Bridge (B4560) – grid references SO 15215 20295 (Forge Road Bridge) upstream to SO 14546 20138.

We are planning to exercise the UK Hazardous Area Response Team (HART) of South East Coast Ambulance Service NHS Foundation Trust between September and October in the discipline of Water Rescue and Flood Response.

We will require access throughout the following dates:

- Thursday 13th September 2018
- Thursday 20th September
- Thursday 27th and Friday 28th September
- Thursday 4th October
- Thursday 11th October
- Thursday 18th October
- Thursday 25th October

They have informed Natural Resources Wales as it is a designated SSSI area – they have written back and are happy with the teams operating in that area. They will of course ensure minimal impact in particular biosecurity (ensuring that all equipment including footwear and clothing is free from invasive non-native species and diseases).

They have also informed the Fishery Owner (via the Wye and Usk Foundation) of the intention to train on the Glan yr Afon beat; they are happy to accommodate the training requirements except for the listed dates where the fishery beat is unavailable:

- Thursday 27th and Friday 28th September
- Thursday 11th October.

Can the Community Council accommodate this request from the NHS?
