7. Report from the County Councillor.

RH has asked Glan Usk to cut back their willow trees on the Bwlch side of the bridge.

Llangynidr Bridge is in the queue for a warning light to show when a vehicle is on the bridge. A Councillor asked if the road level on the Bwlch side of the bridge could be raised – RH will ask again.

There is a new consultation about day care in Crickhowell. There are not many users, currently, and Powys are looking at new ways of providing day care. A befriending pilot was not very successful. Oaklands Care Home is cooking lunches for people who might not want or be able to cook, helping them to remain in their own home. RH urged the Community council to get involved in the consultation.

Reorganization of County Councils and wards in Wales, The Welsh Government is encouraging councils to work together.

The Green Man traffic management committee has not yet asked RH to attend.
