Grants and donations are considered in January and, exceptionally, during the year. In the interests of fairness all applicants must complete this form. Further guidance is given over the page.

GRANTS AND DONATIONS GUIDANCE

- 1. Any bank balance over 4 times the sum of money requested would need explanation to the Council.
- 2. The maximum grant is usually £200, but rare exceptions may be made to this.
- 3. Funds are limited to the assigned budget.
- 4. Applications are accepted all year round but most grants are made in January and this reduces the likelyhood of budget being available at other times in the year.
- 5. Donations to Llangynidr Hall and Recreation Ground Charity, Llangynidr Burial Ground Trust, Brecon Dial-a-ride, Wales Air Ambulance, Brecon Mountain Rescue or Brecon Advice Centre will be considered in January in response to their appeals.
- 6. Retrospective applications will not be considered.
- 7. All applications that meet the criteria will be considered.
